OUR LADY'S MESSAGES

The Revelations and Messages shared at the Queen of the Holy Rosary, Mediatrix of Peace Shrine came from the Blessed Mother, or one of the Saints who assisted Her; such as St. Therese *The Little Flower*, St. Francis, St. Joan of Arc, and others.

Pilgrims who have visited the Shrine on Anniversary Days when the Revelations were given have seen Mary Ann in a state of ecstacy, noticing that she was not conscious of anything or anyone around her as she spoke. These Messages were taken down on a tape recorder; and in long hand by at least two people. Some Messages were repeated word for word as given by the Blessed Mother; however, in most cases Mary Ann was inspired to speak using her own language, grammar, and expressions. Many Messages were also given during suffering periods in her home, especially during Advent and Lent.

In a more general sense, the Revelations and Messages came from the Triumphant Church in Heaven, who used the voice of Mary Ann Van Hoof as a human transmitting device or instrument.

(A transcribed copy of that March 1975 "Statement")

"The Constant Vigil of Prayer"

It has come to my attention that certain individuals from Necedah, Wisconsin, have been promoting in our parishes, and in non-Catholic churches as well, the so-called "Constant Vigil of Prayer". While the concept of continual prayer is praiseworthy in itself, it should be known that the people promoting this particular movement are the same persons who promote "For My God and My Country, Inc." and the so-called "Shrine of Queen of the Holy Rosary Mediatrix of Peace" and also "The Seven Sorrows of the Sorrowful Mother Infants' Home".

Armor of God

"Brethren, be strengthened in the Lord, and in the might of His Power. Put you on the Armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the Deceits of the Devil. For our of God, that you



may be able to resist in the evil day, and to stand wrestling is not against flesh and blood, but against Principalities and Powers, against the Rulers of the World of this Darkness, against the Spirits of Wickedness in the High Place. Therefore, take unto you the Armor in all things perfect. Stand therefore having your loins girt about with Truth, and having on the Breast Plate of Justice, and your feet shod with the preparation of the Gospel of Peace; in all things taking the Shield of Faith, wherewith you may be able to extinguish all the fiery darts of the most Wicked One. And take unto you the Helmet of Salvation and the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God." (Eph. 6, 10-17)

What consists of the Armor of God? God in His Infinite Wisdom and Love has bestowed on Man all that is necessary for his Salvation, and the Salvation of all Souls. What a love this Good Savior has for us! The evils of the World are perpetuated by the Devil, fighting against God for Souls. Thus we see the battle between good and evil playing out in our days. We must take up our armor, we must stand strong for God: "From whence cometh my help? My help is from the Lord."

The battle before us is a Spiritual Battle. In our Baltimore Catechism, we are told that the reason for our existence is to know, love, and serve God in this World; so that one day we may behold Him in Paradise. As Christians we need to resist the Devil and temptations of this World, as well as our own sinful desires, and to serve God's Will alone.

God's Armor has six individual pieces. The first is the BELT OF TRUTH. In Ephesians 6:14, we read, "Stand firm then, with the Belt of Truth buckled around your waist." God's Word is Truth. We have often heard the phrase, "The Truth will set you free." God demands of us to stand for Truth as Soldiers of Christ. His seventh Commandment reiterates the importance of Truth. The Apostle John stated, "Every other piece of the full Armor of God is attached to the Belt of Truth. If you don't begin with Truth, you'll never defeat the enemy. And Jesus said God's Word is true. (John 17:17).

The second piece of armor is the BREASTPLATE OF JUSTICE. God has a righteous character. Psalm 11:7 states, "for the Lord is righteous; He loves righteous deeds; the upright shall behold His face." Again in Psalm

145:17, we read that God "is righteous in all His Ways, and kind in all His Works." We cannot do anything good without God's help. We are lost without Him. No one is righteous by himself. We need the Grace of God.

The third piece of armor are the SHOES OF THE GOSPEL. "and your feet shod with the preparation of the Gospel of Peace" (Ephesians 6:15). Jesus told His Disciples to "go and make Disciples of all Nations; baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost." As His followers, we need to reach out to others and share God's Word. We cannot be lukewarm in our Faith. Our example in word and deed will help save other Souls. This is our Mission on Earth. We are to help each other to reach the Promise of Salvation. It is love for our fellow-man which directs us in this manner.

The SHIELD OF FAITH is the fourth piece of armor. "In all things, taking the Shield of Faith, wherewith you may be able to extinguish all the fiery darts of the most Wicked One." (Ephesians 6:16). Faith is "the substance of things to be hoped for." (Hebrews 11:1). Faith is the evidence of things that appear not. Faith is a shield of protection against the Enemies of our Salvation. St. John says, "This is the victory which over-cometh the World, our Faith." (John 5:4) God has created us simply to labor for our Souls' Salvation, and to become Holy. To this end all our efforts must be directed, and Faith puts us in a position to overcome all the obstacles which the World opposes; obstacles such as human respect, inordinate desires of the flesh, and all the temptations of Hell. The man of Faith triumphs over these obstacles.

The HELMET OF SALVATION is the fifth piece of Our Lord's armor. Ephesians 6:17 states, "Take the Helmet of Salvation". Salvation is a gift from God, freely given through His Son's Death on the Cross. We never have deserved so great a gift. "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the Throne; and to the Lamb!" (Revelations 7:10"). This Helmet of Salvation is our hope for Eternal Life. We must hope for pardon of our sins and the victory over temptation. God permits us at times to experience our own weakness in order that we may acknowledge our misery; and "trust not ourselves, but in God who raiseth the dead." (Cor. 1:9). We also must hope for the Grace of a Happy Death. The nearer we approach our Goal, the more will Hell strive to prevent our reaching it. We read in Holy Scripture that God promises Eternal Salvation, and the means to attain it, to those who believe and pray: "All things, whatsoever you ask when ye pray, believe that you shall receive; and they shall come unto you." (Mark 11:24). "Because he trusteth in Me, I will deliver him; and I will glorify him." (Ps. 90: 14-15).

The sixth piece of armor is the SWORD OF THE SPIRIT. "and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God." (Ephesians 6:17). The Sword of the Spirit is the key weapon in our Spiritual Arsenal. God has

taught us His Word to fight the battle against the Devil, the World, and our own Sinful Nature. Hebrews 4:12-13 says, "For the Word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword; piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And no Creature is hidden from His Sight, but all are naked and exposed to the Eyes of Him to whom we must give account." The Word of God is our roadmap. We must strive each day to increase our Love for Almighty God.

St. Paul goes on to say to the Ephesians, "By all prayer and supplication, praying at all times in the spirit; and in the same watching, with all instances and supplication for all the Saints." (Ephesians 6:18). St. Paul instructs these people that prayer must be constant. To fight the battle against Satan, we must prepare our hearts, souls, and minds; and place them in God's Hands. In other words, prepare for battle.

In order to use these pieces of armor effectively, we must spend time in prayer daily. Every prayer is a humble acknowledgment of the Greatness, or Goodness, or Fidelity, or Mercy of God. It is easy to understand why the Devil is so intent upon turning our thoughts towards worldly affairs during prayer. He desires to rob us of the benefit we derive from fervent prayer; and on the other hand, he wishes to make us guilty of Disrespect towards God. Thus we ought to strive earnestly for great attention and devotion.

True spiritual formation consists in knowing the Infinite Greatness and Goodness of God; together Savior in the Gospel. This it is that renders His yoke so sweet, and His burden so light. In short, the perfect obedience that our Divine Master has enjoined by words and example truly consists in this.

To truly fight the battle ahead, you must wage continual warfare against yourself and employ your entire strength in demolishing each vicious inclination, however trivial. In preparation for the combat, you must summon up all your resolution and courage. No one shall be rewarded with a Crown who has not fought courageously.

Whoever has the courage to conquer his passions, to subdue his appetites, and to repulse even the least motions of his own will performs an action more meritorious in the sight of God; than if, without this, he should tear his flesh with the sharpest disciplines, fast with greater austerity than the ancient Fathers of the Desert, or convert multitudes of sinners.

Now what God expects of us, above all else, is a serious application to conquering our passions; and this is more properly the accomplishment of our duty than if, with uncontrolled appetite, we should do Him a greater service. So we must resolve on a perpetual War with Ourselves. This will obtain for us true humility and knowledge of our own weakness.

Whoever seeks to approach the Eternal Truth and Fountain of All Light, must know himself thoroughly. He must place his complete confidence in

God, and then will receive the assistance of Heaven. Scripture tells us that no one who puts his trust in God will be defeated.

Balancing what we fear from ourselves with what we hope from God, we shall courageously undergo the greatest difficulties and severest trials. By joining these weapons to prayer, we shall be able to execute the greatest plans and gain decisive victories.

In order to acquire complete Confidence in God, we must firmly believe that God is as perfectly capable of conquering a great number of enemies as a few; and equally capable of conquering the strong and experienced as the weak and inexperienced. Although a Soul has labored in vain to tear away from vice and follow virtue, and should find its inclination to evil increasing daily instead of diminishing in favor of virtue, that Soul must not fail to place its confidence in God. It must not be discouraged or abandon its Spiritual Works. On the contrary, that Soul must arouse itself to new fervor and redouble its efforts against the enemy.

In this kind of battle, the victory will be won by him who has the courage not to throw down his arms or put aside his Confidence in God. God's assistance is always present for those that fight His battles, though He may sometimes permit them to be wounded. Persevere to the end. Victory depends on this. There is a swift and effective remedy for the wounds of anyone who fights for God's Cause; and who places his entire trust in Him. When he least expects it, he will see his enemy at his feet.

The primary means to gain Complete Trust in God and conquer our imperfections is through prayer. But to receive full benefit from our prayers, we must desire sincerely to serve God with ardent fervor in the manner most agreeable to Him. We must have a vibrant, living faith; and a firm confidence that God will not refuse the assistance necessary to serve Him faithfully and work out our Salvation. A Soul rekindled with this Holy Confidence is like a Sacred Vessel, into which Divine Mercy pours the treasures of His Grace. The larger the vessel, the greater the abundance of Heavenly Blessings it receives through prayer.

But our motive for prayer must be the Will of God, rather than the will of self. Thus, our intention will not be to make the Divine Will subservient to our own, but rather to transform the human will so that it is in complete harmony with the Divine. The Will of God should be the Will of Men.

If we wish our prayers to be efficacious, our actions must suit the petitions; and we must exert much energy in making ourselves worthy of the favors we ask. For prayer and interior mortification are inseparable; and he that seeks a particular virtue, without making a serious effort to practice it, only tempts God. We must thank God most humbly for the innumerable benefits He has graciously bestowed upon us, before we ask anything of Him.

As the entire force and efficacy of prayer is attributed solely to the Goodness of God, at the conclusion of our petitions we should constantly remember the merits of our Savior's Life and Passion; and His promise to graciously hear our requests. Also, we should have recourse to the intercession of Our Blessed Mother and the other Saints; for they prevail much with God, Who is pleased to honor them in proportion to the honor they accorded Him while they were on Earth.

We must persist in prayer, since God certainly cannot overlook our humble perseverance. For if the pleadings of the Widow in the Gospel prevailed with the Wicked Judge, how can our pleadings be ignored by God, Who is Infinitely Good? Thus, although our favors may not be immediately granted, and may even appear to be ignored by God, we must not lose our confidence in His Infinite Goodness; nor desist from prayer. For God possesses both immense Power and Will to grant us those things conducive to our ultimate welfare. Therefore, if we are not wanting in ourselves, we shall inevitably obtain what we ask for; or something better; or perhaps both.

Let us never cease thanking God and blessing equally His Wisdom, His Goodness, and His Charity; whether He grants or refuses our petition. Whatever happens let us be undisturbed, contented, and resigned to Divine Providence in all things.

Let us also remember that the Rosary is Our Holy Mother's favorite prayer, as it recalls the Life and Death of Her Divine Son. The Power of the Rosary has been proven through the ages. As a weapon against the Enemy of God, this prayer implores Our Holy Mother to come to our assistance. The Rosary has been used to fight heresies and battles. It's power against Satan has been proven again and again. So, let us add this powerful weapon to our Battle Array. Let us put on the Armor of God.

October 7th Anniversary Day Report

It all began with Heaven providing us with a mild beautiful Fall day. Then it started off with our Procession at noon as usual; but this Procession turned out to be very, very impressive. Today it was led by children from

our Queen of the Holy Rosary School, all dressed up in their School Uniforms.

Following after the Crucifix Bearer, three children then led us carrying the American Flag, the Papal Flag, and the God and Country Flag. They were followed by two more children with the carrier of the mounted Blessed Mother Statue. Behind them followed two more children with the carrier of the large Jeweled Crown for the Crowning Ceremony at the Sacred Spot of the Apparitions. Following them were three more children carrying a large

rose-bead Rosary. Then two more children followed carrying a Banner honoring this day as the 70th Anniversary Day Observance. And finally there was one more child carrying the Pro-Life Flag with the rest of the students following behind.











Now it was our turn to be part of the Procession by having the visiting Pilgrims with flags from Poland, Porto Rico, and five States all following them while singing "Ave, Ave, Mater Dei", which is the Shrine Song by Fr. Herbert Duren that he composed to honor Our Lady of Necedah. This was done as they walked through the Shrine Grounds on their way to the Sacred Spot of the Apparitions.

The Prayer Vigil at the Sacred Spot began with the Crowning of the large statue of Our Lady while singing "Bring Flowers of the Rarest" in Her honor, only to be followed by other prayers and songs. Then at 1:00 P.M. the Angelus was recited, along with the fifteen decades of the Rosary.

After the Prayer Vigil refreshments were available in the Mediatrix of Peace Hall, where another special event took place. In addition to the refreshments, Pil-

grims were also treated to viewing a DVD of "The Shrine Story – Early Years"; plus several 16mm films of the 1950 Apparitions. These viewings were very appreciatively received by those in attendance.

Again we need to be thankful to Our Lady for this special day. But we also need to show our appreciation for Her coming to warn us; and to plead for Her help in our "troubling times".

Church Unity

Heaven's Request:

On February 28, 1958 Mary Ann Van Hoof received the following Message from Our Blessed Mother, "Without the Unification of the Eastern Rites with the Roman Rites, we shall not have peace. The conversion of Russia is the answer to peace; and thus meaning the Unification of the Two Branches of the Church into One. Then we shall have peace." This was the first of several similar pleas that Our Holy Mother made.

These prayers are explicit petitions for the conversion of all (baptized and non) into the Catholic Faith; and for Unity under the Supreme Pontiff, the Bishop of Rome and Successor of Saint Peter.

Fr. Paul of Graymoor, while still an Anglican, promoted a worldwide devotion for the Unity of all Christian Churches under the See of Rome. This unity effort he named "The Church Unity Octave." Spreading the ideas that were written in the book "England and the Holy See" by Reverend Spencer Jones, he stated that the Catholic Church alone was the living expression of the full Christian Tradition. The first observance of the Octave was to begin in January, 1908.

It is to his credit that Father Paul, while still an Anglican, gathered the support of both Anglican clergymen and Catholic priests and prelates. These prayers were approved and encouraged by Pope St. Pius X and later extended to the Universal Church by Pope Benedict XV. This octave of prayers eventually led to Fr. Paul's Conversion to the Catholic Faith.

Our Response:

Let us heed the requests of Our Heavenly Mother, and the Popes that She inspired, by praying daily for this Unification of the Eastern Rites with the Roman Rites; so that ALL MAY BE ONE, and we can have the peace that Our Blessed Lady promised.

The CHAIR OF UNITY OCTAVE and the following prayers can be used to help us fulfill this task.

CHAIR OF UNITY OCTAVE JANUARY 18 to 25 PRAY THAT ALL MAY BE ONE

(The Octave is a period of eight days of prayer (Jan. 18-25) for the reunion of Christendom, the return of lapsed Catholics, and the conversion of unbelievers. It was founded by Fr. Paul Jatnes Francis, S.A. in 1908, and

was blessed by St. Pius X in 1909. Since then it has spread to all parts of the Catholic World. The intentions of the Octave are given below.)

- Jan. 18 The union of all Christians to the One True Faith of the Catholic Church.
- Jan. 19 The return of all separated Eastern Catholics to Communion with the Holy See.
- Jan. 20 The reconciliation of Anglicans with the Holy See.
- Jan. 21 The reconciliation of European Protestants with the Holy See.
- Jan. 22 That American Christians become one in union with the Chair of Peter.
- Jan. 23 The restoration of lapsed Catholics to the Sacramental Life of the Church.
- Jan. 24 That the Jewish People come into their inheritance in Jesus Christ.
- Jan. 25 The missionary extension of Christ's Kingdom throughout the World

WHAT WE PRAY FOR

The unity which all men professes to be Christian admits this. But the Unity which Christ offers is that of One Fold and One Shepherd. The Octave aims to secure for all desire in these dark days cannot be had apart from Jesus Christ; as everyone who men this Unity of Christ.

Fr. Paul explained that there is no other Unity possible in the Divine Economy save that which is built upon the same foundation as the one on which Christ Jesus, the Lord and Master, founded His Church; and you know that foundation is: ... "And I say to thee that thou art Peter, and upon this Rock, I will build My Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. And I will give to thee the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven (by which He meant His Church); and whatever thou shall bind upon Earth shall be bound also in Heaven, and whatever thou shall loose upon Earth shall be loosed also in Heaven."

Therefore, when you unit with us in the Observance of the Unity Octave it should be to pray specifically that all those who, down through the centuries, have been separated from the Chair of Peter at Rome may return to Catholic Communion; that is to say, Communion with the Apostolic See.

HOW TO OBSERVE THE OCTAVE

- 1. Recite the Official Prayer daily.
- 2. Assist at Mass and receive Communion daily.
- 3. Pray the Rosary daily for Unity, especially for the Church here.
- 4. Attend Octave exercises in Church.
- 5. Visit the Blessed Sacrament; make the Way of the Cross; perform Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy.
- 6. Offer daily actions for Unity; read good Catholic Literature.
- Give good example to Catholics and non-Catholics.
 Join the League of Prayer for Unity; and continue this Crusade every day of the year.

(Indulgences attached to the Official Prayer)

- 1. Partial Indulgence of 300 days on each day of the Octave in any Church or public oratory where the exercise is performed.
- 2. Plenary Indulgence under usual conditions, at the completion of the Octave

SAINTS IN REVIEW

Saint Clare

Clare was born in 1193 in Assisi, Italy to wealthy parents. She was educated in reading and writing, as well as in the domestic arts of spinning and needlework. Though she was raised among the nobility, she cared little for the social life which surrounded her. She was greatly influenced by the piety of her mother, so decided to dedicate her life to God.

Clare began praying and caring for the poor, even saving food from her family table to distribute to the needy outside the doors of her home. She often heard St. Francis preaching in the streets of Assisi about his new religious community of men called Friars, who relied



solely on alms or begging for their needs. Clare was very inspired by his words.

Clare's parents decided that she would marry a wealthy young man. In desperation at the age of 18, Clare secretly left her father's house and sought out Francis. She begged to be allowed to embrace the new manner of life he had founded. On the night following Palm Sunday, she accepted the Minorite Habit and was received into a life of poverty, penance, and seclusion.

For a short time Clare stayed at a Benedictine Monastery of Nuns near Assisi; and, then moved again for a brief period to a house of female penitents. It was here that she was joined by her sister, Agnes.

Clare and Agnes next moved to the Church of San Damiano, which Francis himself had rebuilt on property given him by the Benedictines. Soon other women joined them. San Damiano became the focal point for Clare's new Religious Order, the "Order of San Damiano". Unlike the Franciscan Friars who moved freely around the Country to preach, a traveling life was hardly conceivable at that time for women; therefore, Clare's sisters lived in enclosure and dedicated their lives to manual labor and prayer.

For a time, Francis himself directed the Order. Then in 1216, Clare accepted the role of abbess at San Damiano. As abbess Clare defended her Order against attempts by prelates to impose on them a Rule that closely resembled the Rule of St. Benedict rather than Francis's stricter Rule that relied on alms only. Clare sought to imitate Francis's virtues and way of life. She saw Francis as a Spiritual Father, and played a significant role in encouraging him and aiding him. She cared for him during his illnesses at the end of his life, and was with him when he died in 1226.

After Francis's death, Clare continued to promote the growth of her Order. She wrote letters to abbesses in other parts of Europe. She fought off attempts by each successive Pope to impose any Rule on her Order which would diminish their radical commitment to corporate poverty. She worked hard despite the poor health which plagued her until her death.

On August 9, 1253, Pope Innocent IV issued the Papal Bull "Solet Annure" which confirmed that Clare's Rule would be the governing Rule for the "Order of Poor Ladies". Two days later, on August 11th, Clare died at the age of 59. Her remains were temporarily placed at the Chapel of San Giorgio until a church to hold her remains could be built.

On August 15, 1255, Pope Alexander IV canonized Clare. Construction of the Basilica of Saint Clare was completed in 1260; and, Clare's remains were transferred to the new Basilica and buried beneath the high altar. In further recognition of St. Clare, Pope Urban IV officially changed the name from the "Order of Poor Ladies" to the "Order of St. Clare", thus leading to the common reference the "Poor Clares".

St. Clare is often depicted in art carrying a monstrance or pyx, the small vessel in which the Communion Host is carried. This commemorates the time when she warded off the soldiers of Frederick II at the gates of her Monastery by displaying the Blessed Sacrament and kneeling in prayer.

Today the Poor Clares number over 20,000 sisters throughout the World, with 16 Federations in over 70 Countries.

PRO-LIFE NEWS

This article is being written while the election process continues to play out in our Country. Sister Lucia, the eldest of the Seers of Fatima, stated before she died, "The Most Holy Virgin in these last times in which we live has given an efficacy to the recitation of the Rosary to such an extent that there is no problem, no matter how difficult it is, whether temporal or above all spiritual, in the personal life of each one of us, of our families... that cannot be solved by the Rosary. There is no problem, I tell you, no matter how difficult it is, that we cannot resolve by the prayer of the Holy Rosary."

Sister Lucia then went on to say, "Since we all need to pray, God asks of us, as a kind of daily installment, a prayer which is within our reach: the Rosary, which can be recited either in common or in private, either in church in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament or at home, either with the rest of the family or alone, either when traveling or while walking quietly in the fields. A mother of a family can say the Rosary while she rocks her baby's cradle or does housework. Our day has 24 hours in it. It is not asking a great deal to set aside a quarter of an hour for the spiritual life, for our intimate and familiar converse with God."

SUPPORTIVE CLERGY/RELIGIOUS

WELCOME to another new Section of our Shrine Newsletter. Through the years many Clergy and Religious from near and far became supportive of the Apparitions at Necedah. By a Reflective Study over the history of some of these supportive members of the Catholic Clergy and Religious, one is led to be very impressed. With the recent passing of Sr. Genevieve, it seemed appropriate to have us ponder over what they must have witnessed to make them so supportive. This first Profile will lead us in that reflective venture.

Fr. J. M. Laplante

Father was a Mission Priest from The Oblates of Mary Immaculate Order in New Brunswick, Canada. In June of 1950 Father wrote to Mrs. Van Hoof acknowledging his awareness of the news regarding the Visits she was having from the Blessed Mother. He was asking for her to speak to Our Lady for him, as his sister was dying from cancer; and a Priest friend of his was losing the Faith.

Because Father was soon going to be on Mission Work in Pittsburg, PA, he planned to seek permission to stay long enough to go to Necedah for the next predicted Visit on August 15th. However, his permission to stay was delayed and he did not receive it in time to attend.

In September of 1950 Father was offered an opportunity to attend the next predicted Visit on October 7th. He flew to Chicago, IL on October 5th; and upon his arrival learned from Fr.McNamare that Fr. Dominic Szymanski was in St. Anthony's Hospital, so quickly went to visit him. Father Dominic told him that he knew Mary Ann Van Hoof when she was living in Kenosha, WI; and then told him lots about the Apparitions and how he also believed in their authenticity.

Father was surprised to learn from Brother Marion Chudy, O.F.M., Assistant Editor of the Immaculata Magazine and promoter of Fr. Dominic's "Rosary Crusade for Peace", that Fr. Dominic was being publicly reprimanded by his superior, Archbishop Kiley of Milwaukee, for undertaking the Peace offensive without permission. However, Father Laplante could not overlook the possibility that Fr. Dominic was being targeted because his Immaculata Magazine was the first Catholic review to take a positive position in favor of the Necedah Apparitions.

After leaving Kenosha and arriving in Necedah on the morning of October 7th, Father met with Mrs. Van Hoof and told her about his visit with Fr. Dominic in the hospital. They both agreed that his


